

RESIDENCIES SASNOVA | 2020/21

Dear residents, we hope you have a nice stay this year.

Due to the pandemic situation, it was necessary to create new rules and procedures to make your stay safer. These measures have a temporary character and can be reverted or changed at any moment, following the evolution of the pandemic and the health authorities' indications.

Residence:

- External visits are not allowed
- There will be alcohol gel on the residence hall and you should use it every time you come to the building
- Masks are mandatory in every common room
- If you choose to wear reusable masks, the usage should be according to manufactures instructions
- Social distance should be assured- minimum 1,6 m
- **The residence signposting must be respected**

Common areas:

- The number of people in each space should be reduced, changing schedules and avoiding crowds
- Meetings in person should be avoided, choosing to do it on-line
- The layout of the common rooms should be respected and so does the maximum capacity displayed in the room
- Furniture/ equipment's will be cleaned regularly by the cleaning teams

Kitchens:

- Whoever uses the kitchen must disinfect their hands, on the way in and out, and also the tables, balconies and products used
- You can take the mask only during the meals
- Meals must be completed in a reasonable amount of time. It is not allowed to hang out in the kitchen.

- Maximum capacity must be respected

WC:

- It is not allowed to leave any personal items inside the WC, after usage the resident should take them to their rooms.
- Sanitary installations are subjected to a hygiene reinforce according to DGS Orientation n.º 014/2020.

Rooms:

- Rooms will mostly have an individual occupation in order to respect the social distance (2 m between beds in double rooms)
- It is not allowed to share wardrobes

If you suspect you may be infected, procedures from the contingency plan must be followed by calling SNS24.
